	<p>Robotics has now become a much sought after field which as many think holds the key to the future. Robotics is an interdisciplinary field that integrates computer science and engineering. It involves design, construction, operation, and use of robots. In fact the term Robotics comes from the Slavic word ‘Robot’ which means slave/servant. The goal of Robotics is to design machines that can help and assist humans. Robotics assimilates elements from the fields of mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, information engineering, mechatronics, electronics, bio engineering, computer engineering, control engineering, software engineering and so on.</p>		
	<p>Robotics develops robots which are programmable machines built to assist humans or mimic human actions. Today there are robots that explore Earth’s harshest conditions, robots that operate in dangerous environments including study of radioactive materials, bomb detection and deactivation robots, those that assist law enforcement and those that assist in almost every aspect of health care. Robots can take on any form but some are made to resemble humans in appearance.</p>		
	<p>It was in 1948 that Norbert Wiener formulated the principles of cybernetics, the basis of practical robotics. It is only in the second half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century that the fully autonomous robots began to appear. The first digitally operated and programmable robot, the Unimate, was installed in 1961 to lift hot pieces of metal from a die casting machine and stack them. The current and potential uses of robots include their use as military robots, industrial robots, cobots (collaborative robots), construction robots, agricultural robots, Medical robots etc. In the near future, thanks to advances in artificial intelligence and programme development technologies, robots will continue getting smarter, more flexible and more energy efficient. Though relatively young, the robotics industry is filled with an admirable promise of progress that science fiction could once only dream about. From the deepest depths of our oceans to thousands of miles in outer space, robots will be found performing tasks that humans couldn’t dream of achieving alone.</p>

Together with her husband, Pierre, she discovered radium, an element widely used for treating cancer, and studied uranium and other radioactive substances. Their amicable collaboration later helped to unlock the secrets of the atom.</p> <p>Marie was born in 1867 in Warsaw, Poland, where her father was a Professor of Physics. At an early age, she displayed a brilliant mind and a blithe personality. Her great exuberance for learning prompted her to continue with her studies after high school. She became disgruntled, however, when she learned that the university in Warsaw was closed to women.</p> <p>Determined to receive higher education, she defiantly left Poland and in 1891 entered the Sorbonne, a French university, when she earned her master's degree and doctorate in Physics. Marie was fortunate to have studied at the Sorbonne with some of the greatest scientists of her day, one of whom was Pierre Curie.
